

**RESOLUTION # 2 OF 2022**

**AUTHORITY TO FOREGO 467 (SENIOR) AND 459-C (DISABLED) EXEMPTION RENEWALS FOR 2022**

**WHEREAS**, Governor Hochul issued Executive Order No. 11.1, which makes it possible for senior citizens and persons with disabilities to have their 2022 property tax exemptions renewed without filing renewal applications, as requested by the New York State Assessors Association, and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of New Haven does hereby authorize the Assessor the authority to require a renewal application when the assessor has reason to believe that an owner who received the exemption on the 2021 roll may have since changed his or her primary residence, added another owner to the deed, transferred the property to a new owner, or died, and

**WHEREAS**, individuals who are eligible for these types of exemptions should confirm via their January 2022 tax bill or with the assessor that they have this type of exemption before assuming it will automatically rollover and with the understanding that all exemptions are due to the Assessor by March 1<sup>st</sup> annually,

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, the Town Board of the Town of *New Haven*, pursuant to the authority granted by Executive Order No. 11.1, issued by the Governor of the State of New York, does hereby direct the Town Assessor of the Town of *New Haven* to grant exemptions on the 2022 assessment roll in accordance with the Resolution.

This resolution shall take effect immediately.
